What is TSP?

TSP is the **Tenant Support Project**. **TSP** provides support to tenants in this building who may be dealing with tough issues, personal matters, or financial problems.

How can TSP help?

TSP can help tenants in many ways -- here are just a few:

- Advocating for public aid or social security benefits
- Helping tenants fill out forms such as Circuit Breaker, LIHEAP, or CTA Reduced Fare Card paperwork
- Helping tenants find jobs through Job Readiness Training and employment counseling
- Finding resources to help tenants get health care and emergency food or transportation
- Negotiating with landlords, or in some cases, helping a tenant who is behind in rent by giving a financial loan or grant

How can I get TSP services?

You are automatically eligible for **TSP** services because you live in this building. You can contact **TSP** by calling **(773) 275-0866** and making an appointment. You are also welcome to stop by our office at **909 W. Wilson**, though you may be asked to wait if you do not have an appointment. All TSP services are free.
