- Between the two sites, Lakeview Pantry will distribute over 1,000,000 pounds of food to about 20,000 people this year.
- We provide food security to all in need between Irving Park and Fullerton, and Damen and Lake Michigan.
- In addition to on-site distribution of food, Lakeview Pantry operates a home delivery program which brings food to more than 110 disabled clients each month.
- We also have a case management program, called Bootstraps, which assists clients in addressing issues beyond food security, such as employment, personal health, and housing.
- Lakeview Pantry operates with the highest attention to efficiency. Our most recent financial audit shows 91% of gifts are applied directly to our programs.
- The average monthly income of our clients is under \$400. Thirty percent of our clients are employed, 30% receive Social Security, and 20% are homeless.
